MINUTES

FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 15

November 28, 2017

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 15 (the "District") met in regular session, open to the public, on the 28th day of November 2017, at the Greater Fort Bend Economic Development Council, One Fluor Daniel Drive, Lakepoint Plaza, Building D, Conference Room, Sugar Land, Texas 77478, outside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

and all of the above were present except Director Kurkjian, thus constituting a quorum.

("Costello"); Pamela Lightbody of AVANTA Services; and Nancy Carter, Shima Jalalipour, Tara Miles, and Keely Campbell of The Muller Law Group, PLLC ("MLG").

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

MINUTES

The Board considered approving the minutes of the October 24, 2017, regular meeting. After review and discussion, Director Groves moved to approve the minutes as submitted. Director Yonish seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

RESIGNATION OF DIRECTOR KURKJIAN

Ms. Carter reported that Director Kurkjian submitted her resignation from the Board of Directors and that Fort Bend County Commissioners Court appointed Rohit Sankholkar to the Board as her replacement.

SWORN STATEMENT, OATH OF OFFICE, AND OFFICIAL BOND OF NEW DIRECTOR

The Board considered accepting the Sworn Statement, Oath of Office, and Official Bond for Rohit Sankholkar. After review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to accept the Sworn Statement, Oath of Office, and Official Bond for Rohit Sankholkar and direct that the documents be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

REORGANIZATION OF BOARD AND DISTRICT REGISTRATION FORM

The Board considered reorganizing the Board of Directors. After review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to (i) appoint Director Sankholkar as the Assistant Secretary/Assistant Vice President and for all other director positions to remain the same and (ii) authorize filing of the District Registration Form, updated to reflect the new director and direct that the District Registration Form be filed in the District's official records. Director Groves seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

OPEN MEETINGS ACT AND PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Ms. Carter reviewed a memorandum regarding the Texas Open Meetings Act and Public Information Act training required for all new directors, noting that Director Sankholkar has 90 days to complete such training.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

Ms. Carter reviewed a memorandum regarding the Conflict of Interest Disclosure Requirements Under Chapter 176 of the Texas Local Government Code and the associated disclosure forms.

TAX ASSESSOR/COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Hebert presented the tax assessor/collector's report, a copy of which is attached. She said that 0.57% of the District's 2017 taxes have been collected as of today. After review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to approve the tax assessor/collector's report and payment of the bills listed in the report. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

RESOLUTION VOTING FOR DIRECTOR FOR FORT BEND CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION

The Board considered adopting a Resolution Voting for Director for Fort Bend Central Appraisal District Board of Directors Election (the "Resolution"). Following review and discussion, Director Groves moved to adopt the Resolution, casting the District's 31 votes for Sam Mayson, Sr., and direct that the Resolution be filed appropriately and retained in the District's records. Director Yonish seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

HURRICANE HARVEY MATTERS

CONSULTING SERVICES FOR FEDERAL GRANTS AND REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAMS

Mr. Patterson and Mr. Reilly reviewed a presentation regarding services offered by Witt O'Brien's, LLC, for federal reimbursement of the District's expenses related to Hurricane Harvey. After review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to approve a contract with Witt O'Brien's, LLC, and direct that the contract be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. Ms. Miles noted that a 1295 Form was received.

AFTER ACTION REPORTS

The Board discussed their review of the After Action Reports presented at the previous Board meeting and requested that the reports be posted to the District's website.

Mr. Hablinski presented a list of recommended projects, a copy of which is attached, based on the After Action Reports. The Board reviewed and discussed the projects and concurred to further discuss the projects at future meetings.

EMERGENCY EVENT COMMUNICATIONS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

PETITION REGARDING ELECTED DIRECTORS

Ms. Carter stated that the District received a Petition for Converting the Board of Directors to Elected Representatives and reported on procedures to verify the petition and establishment of precincts.

FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Lightbody presented the bookkeeper's report, including the list of bills for payment, a copy of which is attached. She noted voiding and re-issuing a check to Director Groves. Following review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to approve the bookkeeper's report and payment of the bills listed in the report. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

OPERATION OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

Mr. Perry presented the operator's report, a copy of which is attached, and reviewed repairs and maintenance performed since the last Board meeting. He stated that the load bank test on the pump station generator will be performed in March, prior to Hurricane season.

MOWING AND WETLANDS MAINTENANCE REPORT

No mowing report was presented.

U.S. ARMY CORPS ("CORPS") OF ENGINEERS PERMIT COMPLIANCE

Mr. Zanzara provided an update on the nutria removal, noting that Berg-Oliver is monitoring the baiting of the nutria traps. He stated that the Corps has indicated its intent to visit the District for an inspection.

The Board considered approving a Master Services Agreement with Berg-Oliver (the "Agreement"). After review and discussion, Director Yonish moved to approve the Agreement, subject to attorney review and receipt of a 1295 Form, and direct that the Agreement be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

FORT BEND COUNTY FLOOD MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION ("FBFMA") AND PERIMETER LEVEE MATTERS

Ms. Carter reported that the next FBFMA meeting will be December 1, 2017, and Director Yonish reported on recent FBFMA matters.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Hablinski presented the engineer's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Hablinski presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 2 in the amount of \$297,581.06, \$249,510.20 of which is the District's share, to Triple B. Services, LLP, for the construction of Clements Crossing Clearing, Detention, and Mass Grading.

Mr. Hablinski presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 2 and Final in the amount of \$4,205.35 to Lindsey Construction, Inc., for the construction of Wetlands Park Grading, along with a final quantity adjustment for a deduction to the contract in the amount of \$31,143.49. He also presented the Certificate of Completion and recommended final acceptance of the project.

Mr. Hablinski presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 5 and Final in the amount of \$87,483.63 to Jaho, Inc., for the construction of paving to serve Cabrera Drive from University Boulevard to LJ Parkway, along with a final quantity adjustment for a deduction to the contract in the amount of \$29,738.44. He also presented the Certificate of Completion and recommended final acceptance of the project.

The Board considered approving a Consent to Encroachment for 5907 Horton River Lane and a Consent to Encroachment for 5419 Rouchel Brook Lane, for landscaping improvements encroaching upon the District's drainage easement (together, the "Consents"). Mr. Hablinski said he had no objection to the encroachments.

After review and discussion and based on the engineer's recommendation, Director Yonish moved to (i) approve the engineer's report, aforementioned pay estimates, and final quantity adjustments; (ii) accept the completed projects; and (iii) approve the Consents and direct that the Consents be filed appropriately and retained in the District's official records. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT'S REPORT

Mr. Schnure presented the landscape architect's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Schnure recommended final acceptance of construction of the North Entrance Park.

Mr. Schnure presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 8 and Final in the amount of \$9,606.94 to Greenyard, Inc. for the construction of landscaping, sitework, and irrigation to serve Avalon, Section 16A, and recommended final acceptance.

Mr. Schnure presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 7 in the amount of \$9,606.98 to HLU Services, Inc., for the construction of landscaping, sitework, and irrigation to serve Avalon, Sections 20 and 24B.

After review and discussion and based on the landscape architect's recommendation, Director Yonish moved to approve the landscape architect's report and the aforementioned pay estimates and to accept the completed projects. Director Groves seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

DEVELOPER'S REPORT

Mr. Hablinski reported on the status of development in Riverstone.

STORMWATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

DECEMBER MEETING DATE

The Board concurred to hold its next meeting on December 19, 2017, at 4:00 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.


