#### **MINUTES**

#### FORT BEND COUNTY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 15

October 21, 2019

The Board of Directors ("Board") of Fort Bend County Levee Improvement District No. 15 ("District") met in regular session, open to the public, on October 21, 2019, at The Club at Riverstone, 18353 University Boulevard, Sugar Land, Texas 77479, inside the boundaries of the District, and the roll was called of the members of the Board:

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no public comments.

#### **CONSENT AGENDA**

#### **MINUTES**

The Board considered approving the minutes of the September 16, 2019, regular meeting and September 30, 2019, special meeting.

#### TAX ASSESSOR/COLLECTOR'S REPORT

Ms. Hebert presented the tax assessor/collector's report, the checks for payment from the tax account, and a delinquent tax attorney report from Perdue, Brandon, Fielder, Collins & Mott, L.L.P., copies of which are attached.

#### FINANCIAL AND BOOKKEEPING MATTERS

Ms. Lightbody presented the bookkeeper's report, a copy of which is attached, including the list of bills for payment and copies of invoices.

After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to approve the i) minutes as submitted, ii) tax assessor's report and payment of the bills listed in the report, and iii) bookkeeper's report and payment of the bills listed in the report. Director Sankholkar seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### FORT BEND COUNTY COMMISSIONER, PRECINCT 4 REPORT

Ms. Carter reviewed recent activities by the office of Fort Bend County Commissioner, Precinct 4, noting the County seminar for levee improvement district directors on November 8, 2019.

#### RENEWAL OF DISTRICT INSURANCE POLICIES

Mr. Hargrave presented a proposal for the District's insurance policies from Harco Insurance. The Board tabled action until later in the meeting.

#### SERIES 2019A UNLIMITED TAX BONDS

Ms. Moran stated that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") may issue its Staff Memorandum approving the application for the issuance of the Series 2019A Unlimited Tax Levee Improvement Bonds ("Bonds") prior to the next Board meeting.

Mr. Hablinski reviewed a revised summary of costs for the levee bond application, noting a revised amount of \$8,900,000 after reducing the contingency for some of the projects as directed by the TCEQ. He reviewed the projects in the bond application, including the i) remainder of the levee segment II, ii) clearing for Clements Crossing, iii) detention for Clements Crossing, iv) remainder of the Snake Slough pump station, and v) remainder of the pump station expansion. Ms. Carter inquired if the Board desired to make any reductions to amounts allocated for each project, and the Board concurred that no changes were necessary.

#### APPOINTMENT OF PAYING AGENT/REGISTRAR

The Board considered appointing the Paying Agent/Registrar for the Bonds. After discussion, Director Anderson moved to appoint The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A., as the Paying Agent/Registrar. Director Misra seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### PRELIMINARY OFFICIAL STATEMENT AND OFFICIAL NOTICE OF SALE

Ms. Moran presented the Preliminary Official Statement and Official Notice of Sale for the Bonds. After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to approve the Preliminary Official Statement and Official Notice of Sale. Director Misra seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### AUTHORIZATION FOR DEVELOPER REIMBURSEMENT REPORT

The Board considered authorizing McGrath to conduct the developer reimbursement report in connection with the Bonds. Mr. McGrath reviewed services to be provided and estimated the fee to be \$5,000 to \$10,000. After review and discussion, Director Anderson

moved to authorize McGrath to conduct the developer reimbursement report. Director Misra seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.

#### ANNUAL REVIEW OF INVESTMENT POLICY

The Board conducted its annual review of the District's Investment Policy. Ms. Carter said the Investment Officer did not recommend any changes. After review and discussion, Director Sankholkar moved to adopt a Resolution Regarding Annual Review of Investment Policy, noting no changes. Director Anderson seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

# RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AUTHORIZED DEPOSITORY INSTITUTIONS AND ADOPTING LIST OF QUALIFIED BROKER/DEALERS WITH WHOM THE DISTRICT MAY ENGAGE IN INVESTMENT TRANSACTIONS

The Board reviewed a Resolution Establishing Authorized Depository Institutions and Adopting List of Qualified Broker/Dealers with whom the District may Engage in Investment Transactions ("Resolution"), updating the list of banks with which the District may conduct business. After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to adopt the Resolution. Director Misra seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

# RESOLUTION VOTING FOR DIRECTOR FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION FOR FORT BEND CENTRAL APPRAISAL DISTRICT

The Board tabled this agenda item, pending receipt of the ballot from the appraisal district.

#### FINANCE COMMITTEE MATTERS

#### **VENDOR EVALUATION**

Ms. Carter stated that the Board is scheduled to meet with Berg Oliver on November 14, 2019, at 4:00 p.m., to conduct a site visit at Alcorn Bayou and for the Board's evaluation of their services to the District.

#### GENERAL MANAGER

Discussion ensued regarding the draft Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") for the proposed General Manager position for the District. The Board concurred to review the draft RFQ and provide feedback at the next meeting.

#### ELECTRONIC RECORDS MANAGEMENT AND ON-LINE ACCESS MATTERS

Director Misra reported on his research of alternative storage options for District records, noting that the Texas State Library can store records for \$0.24 per box per month. Ms. Carter said MLG's proposed new records management policy follows the Texas State Library recommended records retention schedule.

The Board considered approving a new Service Agreement with Off Cinco to provide for the addition of director email accounts, as the Board directed at the August meeting. After review and discussion, Director Misra moved to approve the new Service Agreement with Off Cinco, reflecting the addition of email accounts. Director Sankholkar seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

#### STORMWATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

#### LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT'S REPORT

Mr. Schnure presented the landscape architect's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Schnure presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate Nos. 10 and 11 in the respective amounts of \$61,269.26 and \$4,260.00 to Earth First Landscapes for the construction of landscape facilities to serve Avalon, Section 17.

Mr. Schnure presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 7 in the amount of \$21,248.55 to Classic Irrigation and Landscape for the construction of landscape facilities to serve Avalon, Section 14.

After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to accept the Landscape Architect's report and approve the aforementioned pay estimates. Director Misra seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS PERMIT AND WETLANDS COMPLIANCE

Mr. Perry stated that he obtained a price of \$29,500 from Triple B. Services, L.P., to lower the wetland planting area 18" in order to prepare the site for the wetland plantings required by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit. Following discussion, Director Anderson moved to authorize the lowering of the wetland planting area in an amount not to exceed \$29,500. Director Sankholkar seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote.

#### MOWING AND WETLANDS MAINTENANCE

Mr. Koehl said Yellowstone is working with Berg Oliver on the nutria abatement and removing dead trees in Alcorn Bayou.

#### GENERAL OPERATION MATTERS

Mr. Perry presented the operator's report, a copy of which is attached, and reported on maintenance and repairs to District facilities since the last meeting.

Mr. Perry reported that pump 1 from the Alcorn Bayou pump station is still under repair and that the cost for repair is \$28,862.00, which is not under warranty. He said he will confirm the deductible amount with the District's insurance company and pursue a claim if appropriate. He said he expects the pump to be repaired within a few weeks.

#### **EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PROJECTS**

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

#### ENGINEERING MATTERS

Mr. Hablinski presented and reviewed the engineer's report, a copy of which is attached.

Mr. Hablinski presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 5 in the amount of \$291,239.68 to B-5 Construction Co., Inc., for the construction of the Snake Slough Pump Station, along with a 6-day extension to the contract time due to wet weather.

Mr. Hablinski presented and recommended approval of Pay Estimate No. 6 in the amount of \$217,770.18, the District's share of which is \$2,889.00, to Triple B. Services, L.P., for the construction of the Hagerson Road Watershed Interconnect.

After review and discussion and based on the engineer's recommendation, Director Anderson moved to approve the aforementioned pay estimates and time extension. Director Misra seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Mr. Hablinski presented a draft park bond cost summary, a copy of which is attached. He stated that he needed Board authorization to prepare the application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. The Board concurred to review the cost summary and discus it again at the next meeting.

#### **EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN**

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

#### REGIONAL STEEP BANK CREEK WATERSHED MODELING PROJECT

Ms. Carter stated that a meeting is scheduled among the districts participating in the 2D regional watershed modeling project on October 30, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.

#### **COMMUNICATIONS MATTERS**

Ms. Wolf reported on 180 Messaging, Inc.'s website and social media activity for the District, noting that the newsletter will be posted this week.

# FORT BEND FLOOD MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION ("FBFMA") AND PERIMETER LEVEE MATTERS

Ms. Carter stated that the next FBFMA meeting will be December 13, 2019.

#### **DEVELOPER'S REPORT**

No report on development was presented.

# ORDER ADOPTING AMENDED AND RESTATED RECORDS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Ms. Carter discussed the proposed new records management program. The Board requested additional time to review the order and to consider it at the next meeting.

#### RENEWAL OF DISTRICT'S INSURANCE POLICIES (CONT'D)

Mr. McDonald presented and reviewed the insurance renewal proposal from McDonald Wessendorff. After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to approve the proposal from McDonald Wessendorff effective, October 23, 2019, with further evaluation by the Finance Committee for any necessary changes in coverage. Director Misra seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### ORDER AMENDING AND RESTATING POST-ISSUANCE COMPLIANCE POLICY

Ms. Carter presented an Order Amending and Restating Procedures for Post-Issuance Compliance ("Order"), which sets forth procedures to be followed by District consultants following the issuance of bonds. After review and discussion, Director Anderson moved to adopt the Order. Director Sankholkar seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

# COORDINATION OF PLANNING MEETING WITH OTHER RIVERSTONE DISTRICTS AND STAKEHOLDERS

There was no discussion on this agenda item.

#### COMMITTEE REPORTS AND SCHEDULING OF MEETINGS

The Board concurred to hold its next regular meeting on Monday, November 18, 2019, at 4:00 p.m., at the offices of MLG due to The Club's unavailability.

#### OPERATIONS (CONT'D)

Ms. Carter noted that BugCo had contacted her to advise that they recommended discontinuation of mosquito spraying at the end of October. The Board concurred with the recommendation.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the Board concurred to adjourn the meeting.

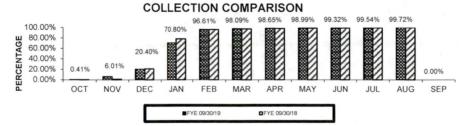

- Working with Berg Oliver Consultant on Alcorn Bayou clean outs for better drainage.
  - Yellowstone presented proposal, working on hold pending site visit.

#### Outfalls/Pump Station:

- Pump 1 pulled for repairs. Work not warranty, pump due back end of October.
- \$28,862.00 in repairs, \$8,000 for pull and reinstall.

#### **Steep Bank Creek Pump Station:**

- 12 temporary pumps remain deployed, 1 pump is being repaired is complete and back installed.
- Pump covers have arrived and been installed.
- RMS system still being review by committee. Update on pump station expansion project.
- Emergency gate repairs approved, contract being worked on through MLG for a December start date.

#### **Discussion Topics:**

- FEMA claims are ongoing.



#### Tropical Storm Imelda:

- Tropical Storm Imelda hit Fort Bend County on Monday 9/16/19 dropping very little rain in the district. All drainage channels and detention were well inside of bank and the district remained on gravity flow the entire week. On Thursday 9/19/19, 4" of rain fell in a 6-hour span which did cause major street ponding throughout the district, and roads around Riverstone to be impassible until rains slowed and water receded. A total of 5.6" of rainfall feel in Riverstone during the week of the storm. Currently the river projects are staying well out of Action Stage, and no increased river levels are projected.
